STEP 8: Command your lights using the prompts on the back page!

PRO TIP: Use Automations in the Google Home app to create additional actions, like turning on and off multiple devices. To create an automation:

A. Click the Automations icon in the bottom navigation.

B. Tap the (+) button in the bottom right corner.

C. Choose the type of Routine, ie. Personal or Household, to control who can see and edit the Automation.

C. Name your Routine.

D. Add a "Starter" command, from the options.

E. Click an "Action" command. You can turn on and off a Zone (to white) by tapping the Device (ie. Zone name), or you can automate a pattern by scrolling down and tapping "Add Scenes" to select one ore more Oelo pattern/zone combinations from the list.

Hey Google	Let there be light.	The specified Zone or Group designated in your Automations turns on to white.	The user must create this command under Automations and " Try adding your own."
